Legal Basis: ORC 4725.45 and 4743.05; Section 349.10 of Am. Sub. H.B. 1 of the 128th General Assembly (originally established by Am. Sub. H.B. 152 of the 120th G.A.)

Purpose: This line item is used to pay the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board's operating expenses, including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment. The Board issues licenses to opticians and ocularists and investigates complaints, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, and monitors continuing education compliance. (An ocularist is a person who is engaged in the designing, fabricating, and fitting of an artificial eye or of prostheses associated with the appearance or function of the human eye.)
