Purpose: This line item is used to pay the State Chiropractic Board's operating expenses,

including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment. The Board issues licenses for chiropractors (as well as acupuncture certificates to qualified chiropractors), sets the standards of practice, tests each applicant on the Board's laws

and rules, investigates complaints, holds administrative hearings, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, reviews and approves continuing education programs, and monitors continuing education compliance among licensees.
