Legal Basis: ORC 4713.02 and 4743.05; Section 249.10 of H.B. 110 of the 134th G.A.

Purpose: This appropriation item supports the operating expenses of the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board. The board is responsible for licensing and regulating individuals and salons in the fields of cosmetology, esthetics, manicuring, and tanning, as well as barbers, barber shops, and barber schools. Licenses are renewed biennially.
