- Legal Basis:** ORC 4731.24; Sections 335.10 and 335.20 of H.B. 110 of the 134th G.A. (originally established by H.B. 215 of the 122nd G.A.)
- Purpose:** This line item is used to pay the State Medical Board's operating expenses, including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment. The professionals licensed or certified by the Board include physicians, physician assistants, massage therapists, acupuncturists, and genetic counselors. The Board sets standards of practice, investigates complaints, holds administrative hearings, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, and monitors continuing education compliance for its licensees. In addition, in FY 2022, H.B. 110 requires up to \$5,000 be used to create a brochure or other educational materials regarding the right of conscience established in section 4743.10 of the Revised Code.
