Purpose: This line item pays for the operating expenses of the Liquor Control Commission, which ensures compliance with liquor laws and regulations and provides impartial hearings related to violations of state liquor laws that could result in fines or the suspension or revocation of liquor permits. These expenses include personnel, equipment, and maintenance costs, as well as contracted court reporting and transcript services, servicing of writs, and witness reimbursements.
