

## State general operating revenue grew 70.2% in the past two decades

- In nominal terms, state general operating revenue increased 70.2% since FY 2005, from \$27.41 billion to \$46.65 billion in FY 2025.
- State tax receipts are the largest component at \$30.11 billion (64.5%) in FY 2025, having risen 48.3% since FY 2005.
- Federal grants are the next largest component at \$14.18 billion (30.4%) in FY 2025, having risen 151.2% since FY 2005.
- State general operating revenue rose by about \$2.83 billion (6.4%) from FY 2024 to FY 2025.
