

Section II: Active Licenses, FY 2010 and FY 2011

Table 3 lists the total number of active licenses for each board or commission for FY 2010 and FY 2011 and the percent change in the total number of licenses between these two fiscal years. Of the 40 boards and commissions, 20 reported increases in the number of active licenses and 20 reported decreases. Two boards and commissions reported increases in active licenses of more than 10% and two reported decreases of more than 10%.
