


State Government Operating Expenses

August 2023





The December 2022 head count of state employees was 48,636, the lowest count since 1983 and 29.1% lower than the highest count of 68,573 that was recorded in 1994.

- 90.1% (43,840) of the 48,636 state employees were full-time permanent employees.
- For FY 2023, the state government's operating expenses amounted to \$9.94 billion (10.6% of total state budget expenditures) across all funds:
 - \$5.49 billion (5.9%) for employee payroll, including both salaries and fringe benefits;
 - \$2.04 billion (2.2%) for purchased personal services; and
 - \$2.41 billion (2.6%) for supplies and maintenance and equipment.
