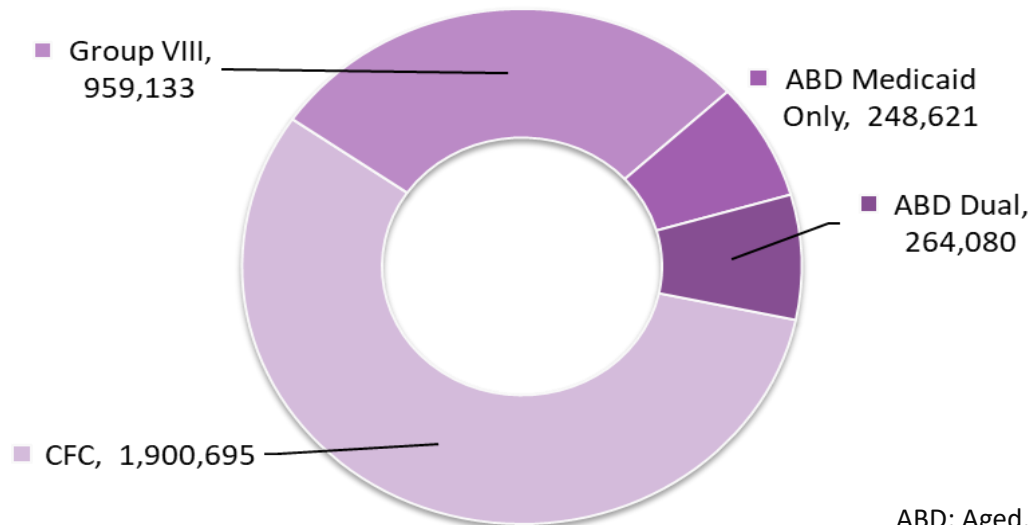
Medicaid Caseload at a Glance

December 2023

Approximately three
in ten Ohioans were
enrolled in Medicaid
in FY 2023

- ◆ 3.51 million (29.9%) of Ohio's 11.76 million residents were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2023.
- ◆ 3.37 million (96.0%) of Medicaid enrollees received full benefits; 141,000 (4.0%) received limited or Medicare premium or copayment assistance benefits.
- ◆ Of the 3.37 million enrollees who received full benefits, 3.05 million (90.3%) were served by managed care (MC) plans, and 326,000 (9.7%) were served by fee-for-service (FFS) care.

Distribution of Ohio's 3.37 Million Full Benefit Recipients by Coverage Group



ABD: Aged, Blind, and Disabled
CFC: Covered Families and Children
Dual: Eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare
Group VIII: Expansion group established by the Affordable Care Act

Service Methods for CFC

- ◆ 96.7% of enrollees received managed care
- ◆ 3.3% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for Group VIII

- ◆ 89.4% of enrollees received managed care
- ◆ 10.6% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for ABD Medicaid Only and ABD Dual

- ◆ 80.7% of Medicaid Only enrollees received managed care, and 19.3% of Medicaid Only enrollees received FFS care
- ◆ 57.0% of Dual enrollees received managed care, and 43.0% of Dual enrollees received FFS care
