Provides that a statement of neglect added to the nurse aide registry regarding a nurse aide or other individual may be removed, and any accompanying information expunged if, in the judgment of the Director of Health, the neglect was a singular occurrence and the employment and personal history of the nurse aide or other individual does not reflect a pattern of abuse or neglect. Provides that the petition for rescission and the Director's notice that it has been granted are not subject to expungement and are not public records.	Same as the Executive.	No provision.	Same as the Executive.

Modifies the Director's authority to issue subpoenas regarding alleged abuse and neglect of a long-term care facility resident by permitting the Director to do the following: (1) issue subpoenas for "other evidence," rather than only for witnesses and documents, (2) issue subpoenas for purposes of an investigation, rather than only for purposes of a hearing, and (3) serve subpoenas by means of a representative of the Director. 3 BOR - 74 Nurse Education Assistance Loan Program	<p data-bbox="790 380 1051 407">R.C. 3333.28</p> <p data-bbox="790 435 1365 938">Changes the allocation of 25% of the Nurse Education Assistance Fund from loans to students in prelicensure professional nurse education programs for licensed practical nurses to loans to students in any nurse education programs, as determined by the Chancellor. Requires the Chancellor to give preference to programs aimed at increasing enrollment in an area of need. (Under continuing law, 50% is allocated to registered nurses in postlicensure nurse education programs with the intent to become nursing instructors and 25% to students in prelicensure nurse education programs for registered nurses.)</p> <p data-bbox="790 954 1365 1015">Fiscal effect: May affect which students receive loans.</p>	<p data-bbox="1408 380 1669 407">R.C. 3333.28</p> <p data-bbox="1408 435 1983 699">Replaces the House provision with a provision that allocates the 25% currently allocated to students in programs for licensed practical nurses to registered nurses in postlicensure nurse education programs with the intent to become nursing instructors, increasing the percentage allocated to these nurses to 75%.</p> <p data-bbox="1408 954 1983 982">Fiscal effect: Same as the House.</p>	<p data-bbox="2032 380 2292 407">R.C. 3333.28</p> <p data-bbox="2032 435 2292 462">Same as the House.</p> <p data-bbox="2032 954 2502 982">Fiscal effect: Same as the House.</p>
