R.C. 121.31

Changes the political party affiliation of the House and Senate appointees to the Commission on Hispanic-Latino affairs by requiring that the House Speaker appoint a House member of the majority party, and the Senate President appoint a Senate member of a political party different than that of the House member.

No provision.

R.C. 121.31

Increases, from two to four, the number of non-voting legislative members who serve on the Commission on Hispanic-Latino Affairs and requires the Speaker of the House and President of the Senate to each appoint two members, one from the majority party and one from the minority party from their respective houses.
