### Department of Natural Resources (DNR)

DNRCD23 Hunting licenses, three-day small game hunting licenses, deer and wild turkey permits, fur taker permits, wetland habitat stamps, fishing licenses, and multi-year hunting and fishing licenses (These fees are used to support the operations of DNR's Division of Wildlife.)

Allows the Chief of the Division of Wildlife to adopt above mentioned fees in rules, in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code and with the approval of the DNR Director and the Wildlife Council, in lieu of the statutorily imposed fees. Makes the following fee changes in statute until the fees pursuant to rules are established:
