

Controlling Board

Purpose: This fund's statutory authority provides that the money appropriated to this line item may be used by the Controlling Board at the request of a state agency or the Director of Budget and Management for the purpose of providing disaster and emergency aid to state agencies and political subdivisions or for other purposes approved by the Controlling Board.
