Purpose: This line item is used to support the general operating expenses, including payroll, supplies, and equipment, for the Ohio State Barber Board. The Board licenses barbers, barber teachers, barber shops, and barber schools, with barbers and barber shops accounting for almost all of the licenses. The number of active licenses among all four license types was 12,500 in FY 2013. The Board renews licenses on a biennial basis.
