Legal Basis: ORC 4709.04 and 4743.05; Section 225.10 of H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A.

Purpose: This line item is used to support the general operating expenses, including payroll, supplies, and equipment, for the Ohio State Barber Board. The Board licenses barbers, barber teachers, barber shops, and barber schools, with barbers and barber shops accounting for almost all of the licenses. The Board renews licenses on a biennial basis in odd-numbered fiscal years. Funding for FY 2018 carries the Board through January 21, 2018, when its operations are to be consolidated with those of the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology under the newly-created State Cosmetology and Barber Board. Thereafter, funding for regulating the barbering profession will be included under the budget of the State Cosmetology and Barber Board.
