Legal Basis: ORC 4713.02 and 4743.05; Section 249.10 of H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A.

Purpose: H.B. 49 consolidates the functions and responsibilities of the Ohio State Barber Board and State Board of Cosmetology under the State Cosmetology and Barber Board, effective January 21, 2018. This appropriation supports the operating expenses of the State Board of Cosmetology until that time, and the operating expenses of the consolidated board thereafter. The consolidated board will be responsible for licensing and regulating individuals and salons in the fields of cosmetology, esthetics, manicuring, and tanning, as well as barbers, barber shops, and barber schools. Licenses are renewed biennially.
