Legal Basis: ORC 4736.06 and 4743.05; Section 389.10 of H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A. (originally established by H.B. 152 of the 120th G.A.)

Purpose: H.B. 49 abolishes the Board and transfers its responsibilities to the Ohio Department of Health on January 21, 2018. This line item supports general operating expenses, including payroll, supplies, and equipment, for the Ohio State Board of Sanitarian Registration until that time. The Board licenses and regulates sanitarians, who are professionals that are engaged in the field of environmental health. The Board also sets standards of practice, investigates complaints, holds administrative hearings, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, and monitors continuing education compliance among licensees.
