**Legal Basis:** ORC 4731.24; Section 335.10 of H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A. (originally established by H.B. 215 of the 122nd G.A.)

**Purpose:** This line item is used to pay the State Medical Board's operating expenses, including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment. The professionals licensed or certified by the Board include physicians, physician assistants, massage therapists, acupuncturists, and genetic counselors. The Board establishes standards for education, preprofessional training, and examination for these professionals. The Board also sets standards of practice, investigates complaints, holds administrative hearings, determines appropriate disciplinary actions, and monitors continuing education compliance for its licensees.

H.B. 49 transferred the regulation of dietitians and respiratory care therapists to the State Medical Board on January 21, 2018.
