Legal Basis: ORC 4755.03, 4743.05, and 4779.08; Section 347.10 of H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A. (originally established by H.B. 152 of the 120th G.A.)

Purpose: This line item supports general operating expenses, including personal services, supplies, maintenance, and equipment, for the Ohio Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board. The Board licenses and regulates the professions of occupational therapy, physical therapy, athletic training, orthotics, prosthetics, and pedorthics. The Board also sets standards of practice, investigates complaints, determines appropriate disciplinary action, and approves continuing education programs.

H.B. 49 of the 132nd G.A. transferred the regulation of orthotists, prosthetists, and pedorthists to the Board on January 21, 2018.
