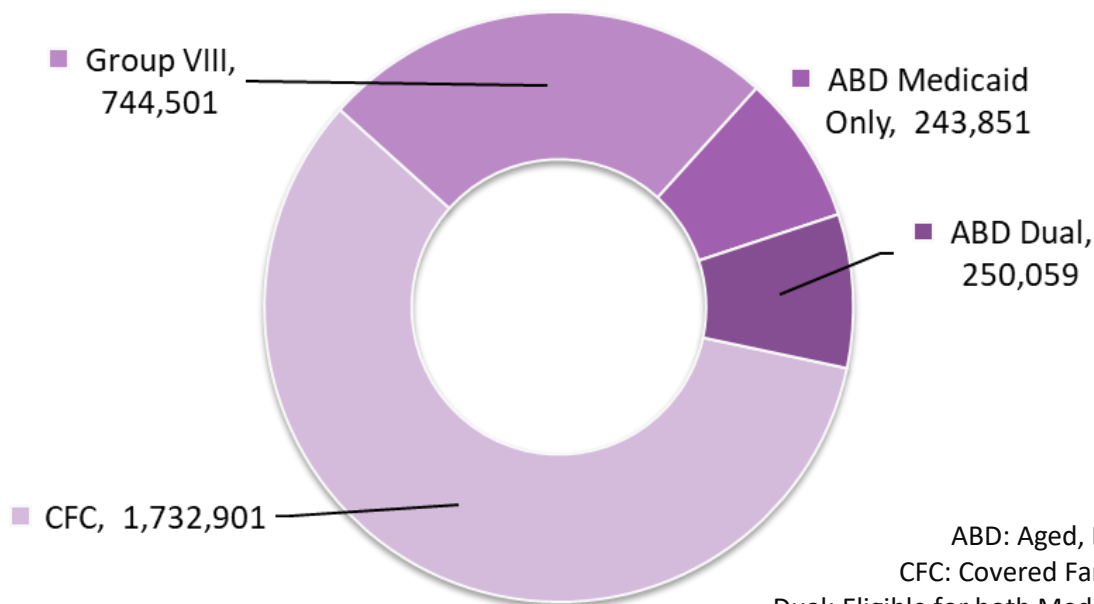
Medicaid Caseload at a Glance

September 2021

More than one out of four Ohioans were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2021

- ♦ 3.11 million (26.3%) of Ohio's 11.80 million residents were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2021.
- ♦ 2.97 million (95.6%) of Medicaid enrollees received full benefits; 138,000 (4.4%) received limited or Medicare premium or copayment assistance benefits.
- ♦ Of the 2.97 million enrollees who received full benefits, 2.74 million (92.3%) were served by managed care (MC) plans, and 230,000 (7.7%) were served by fee-for-service (FFS) care.

ABD: Aged, Blind, and Disabled
CFC: Covered Families and Children
Dual: Eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare

Group VIII: Expansion group established by the Affordable Care Act

Service Methods for CFC

- ♦ 98.2% of enrollees received managed care
- ♦ 1.8% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for Group VIII

- ♦ 94.4% of enrollees received managed care
- ♦ 5.6% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for ABD Medicaid Only and ABD Dual

- ♦ 83.2% of Medicaid Only enrollees received managed care, and 16.8% of Medicaid Only enrollees received FFS care
- ♦ 53.3% of Dual enrollees received managed care, and 46.7% of Dual enrollees received FFS care
