

## Section II: Active Licenses, FY 2013 and FY 2014

Table 3 lists the total number of active licenses for each board or commission for FY 2013 and FY 2014 and the percent change in the number of licenses between these fiscal years. Of the 39 boards and commissions listed in the table, 24 reported increases in the number of active licenses and 15 reported decreases. Three boards and commissions reported increases in active licenses of more than 10%, and five reported decreases of more than 10%. Licenses first issued in FY 2014 are noted as "(new)," and discontinued licenses are noted as "(discontinued)."
