Contents: Requires motor vehicle headlights to comply with federal standards for headlamp color

State Fiscal Highlights

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal effect on local governments.

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill requires that a vehicle's headlights comply with the headlamp color requirements contained in the federal motor vehicle safety standards. The Ohio Administrative Code currently requires headlights to display a white light. As a white light complies with federal standards, the bill does not create a new requirement and, therefore, will not have any fiscal impact on state or local governments.
