BILL SUMMARY

- Creates the Disabled American Veteran license plate and requires a \$25 contribution that is paid to the private organization Disabled American Veterans Department of Ohio.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Disabled American Veteran license plate

The bill creates the "Disabled American Veteran" license plate, which is:

- (1) Available to the general public;
- (2) Inscribed with identifying words or markings that are approved by the Disabled American Veterans Department of Ohio (a private organization) and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles; and
- (3) Issued upon the payment of a \$25 contribution, an administrative fee of \$10, all other applicable license taxes and fees, and compliance with applicable motor vehicle registration laws.¹

The Registrar must transmit the \$25 contributions to the Treasurer of State for deposit into the existing License Plate Contribution Fund. The bill then requires the Registrar to pay those contributions to the Disabled American Veterans Department of Ohio, which must use the contributions to pay for programs that serve disabled American veterans and their families.²

The bill requires the Registrar to deposit the \$10 Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) administrative fee into the existing State Bureau of Motor Vehicles Fund, for the purpose of compensating the BMV for additional services required in issuing Disabled American Veteran license plates.³
